Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and assets credit history and credit scores employment information and income When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Asertaloans Inc chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Asertaloans Inc protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Asertaloans Inc collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply for a loan or give us your income information • provide account information or provide employment information • show your driver's license <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>Asertaloans Inc does not have any affiliates.</i></p>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>Asertaloans Inc shares information with nonaffiliates (such as lenders/investors, loan processing companies, 3rd party loan processors, real estate agents/realtors, appraisal companies, etc.) for purposes related to applicants' transactions.</i></p>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

Opting-Out Rights	
<p>Under Regulation P §1016.10(a), you have the right to opt out of AsertaLoans sharing your nonpublic personal information (NPI). You may opt out by one of the methods below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Email: Send an email request to aaron@asertaloans.com and put "Opt Out Request" within 30 days of you acknowledging this notice. 2. Company's Customer Information Security Policy Statement

Asertaloans has adopted this Customer Information Security Policy (CIS Policy) designed to protect customer information, including administrative, technical, and physical safeguards used by Asertaloans to access, collect, distribute, process, protect, store, use, transmit, dispose of, or otherwise handle customer information. In developing the CIS Policy, Asertaloans has considered its size and complexity, the nature and scope of its activities, and the sensitivity of any customer information at issue.

The objectives of customer information security are designed to:

Ensure the security and confidentiality of customer information.

Protect against any anticipated threats or hazards to the security or integrity of customer information.

Protect against unauthorized access to or use of such information that could result in substantial harm or inconvenience to any customer.

There are many critical elements of the CIS Policy, including assigning accountability, assessing risk, continuing training and education, developing internal controls, testing and monitoring, overseeing service providers, and planning for future developments.
